# 2020 Withdrawal of Centre status Policy



2020 Safety Training are committed to the Centre, the Awarding Body and Candidates

In the event of 2020 STL losing Centre Status or going into insolvency we will:

1. Contact the Awarding Body to inform them of what the Centre will be doing to support the Candidates.
2. Inform all Candidates of the situation.
3. Try and find another training provider to take on the Candidates.
4. Cooperate with the Awarding Body.
5. Complete an Exit review for the Awarding Body if necessary.
6. If 2020 Safety Training LTD are in a current situation to pay the Candidates back, they will do so.

Additionally, we will endeavour to support candidates from other centres who choose to move across to us, by setting up a mapping session to align completed works with our own assessment plans.

2020 Safety Training LTD are committed to their Candidates and Staff and will do everything in their power to support everyone in the unlikely event that the completion of training or assessments cannot be completed.
